Dicentrarchus labrax, (Linnaeus, 1758) **European seabass** 



Adult, my common length is around 70 to 50 cm. My maximum height is 110 cm.



### Habitat

They find me mainly above the sandy or rocky bottoms of the littoral fringe, in estuaries, lagoons and at the mouths of rivers. I enter it thanks to the brackish water upwelling and in the ports. Sometimes I venture upstream into fresh water. Young people of my species live in schools, then they become solitary as they get older. I swim in depths of 0 to 30 meters.



My taste for food differs according to my growth. Being young and sub-adults, we mainly consume crustaceans. At the adult stage we still consume crustaceans, but also cephalopods (squid), and especially fish (sardines, anchovies, pout, etc.). My reputation as a predator is well established!
