Mullus surmuletus (Linnaeus, 1758) Surmullet



As adult, my maximum length is 40 cm. My average length is between 10 to 25 cm.

I am a gregarious fish, often accompanied by friends. As my name suggests, and unlike my cousin the red mullet, I prefer rocky areas. However, I do occasionally visit the soft bottoms: sand, gravel, eelgrass or Posidonia meadows. I am abundant between 15-25m deep, but larger individuals tend to frequent depths between 80-100m.



I swim in the eastern Atlantic: western Norway, the English Channel to Senegal and the Canary Islands, including the Mediterranean sea and the Black Sea.



I search my food with the help of my two characteristic barbs. Adult, I feed on worms, shrimps, crustaceans, molluscs that I look for in the sediment. The young feed on copepods, amphipods, small crustaceans. Babies (pelagic larvae) enjoy zooplankton, copepods and crustacean larvae.



The number of my teeth decreases during my growth and disappears after reaching adulthood (Aguirre, 1997).
