



# Call for Projects "Complex Springboard" 2024 Academy Complex Systems UCA<sup>JEDI</sup>

#### **About**

The "COMPLEX SPRINGBOARD" 2024 ("Tremplin Complex") call for proposals is dedicated to setting up international scientific networks. It aims to facilitate the access of researchers belonging to the perimeter of the "Complex Systems" Academy to funding programs such as Horizon Europe or ANR bilateral calls.

The goal of this instrument is thus **to strengthen the scientific positioning of Université Côte d'Azur** by coordinating a proposal submitted in response to international calls for proposals.

## Eligibility criteria

## The proposal is eligible if:

- the project leader identifies and targets at least one international call (in particular H2020 or ANR bilateral programs) in his/her proposal;
- the proposal aims to **build an interdisciplinary scientific network** at a recognized European or international level;
- the research project falls within a theme of the Academy "Complex Systems" (details of the research areas here);
- the project coordinator is a researcher from Université Côte d'Azur or from IdEx partners.

Support is provided to a single beneficiary.

It should be noted that those who wish to establish collaborations to coordinate a **European project**, **for the first time**, **are particularly encouraged to apply**.

#### Evaluation criteria

The criteria considered for the evaluation of the proposal are the following:

- Quality and credibility of the network envisaged in the context of the targeted international call;
- Relevance of networking plans;
- Suitability of the proposed project to the intended call;
- Capacity of the proposed project to be competitive for the targeted call.

## Eligible expenses

Eligible expenses for this call relate exclusively to operating costs. They include in particular the costs of **missions**, **invitations**, **receptions** as **well** as **the organization of seminars/conferences in relation to the project, or even writing or proofreading costs**. Staff costs (trainees, doctoral students, post-doctoral students) are not eligible.

• The maximum amount of the grant is **5.000**€.

Received funding must be consumed no later than December 15, 2025 (notion of service done).



- Call open on the Nuxeo platform from 14/09/2023 until 15/11/2023 at 5 p.m.
- Communication of evaluation results: from mid-December 2024, beginning of January 2024
- ➤ Applications should include:
  - The attached application form, duly completed.
  - Short CV of the project leader.
  - Any document deemed relevant by the applicant.

All the documents requested must be concatenated in a single PDF file, named according to the following scheme: NAME of the project\_Porteur\_2024.pdf.
