As part of *les Prix de la Fondation*, the Fondation Université Côte d'Azur is launching its annual call for applications for the following categories:

Prix Talents & Inclusion

Prix Talents & Solidarité

with the aim of supporting students facing demanding personal situations (disability or social insecurity) and whose academic path demonstrates remarkable perseverance and commitment.

All students enrolled in EURs, departments, and programs at Université Côte d'Azur are eligible, from the second year of a Bachelor's degree (Licence 2 or equivalent) up to Master 2 – MSc2.

Article 1: Eligibility Criteria

To apply for *les Prix de la Fondation*, applicants must:

- Be a student enrolled in Licence 2, Licence 3, Master, MSc, or equivalent (Licence 1 level is not accepted: for academic evaluation, we can only review applications starting from Licence 2 or equivalent).
- Not have received a Prize awarded by the Foundation in previous years.
- Have completed their administrative enrollment for the current academic year.

Article 2: Selection and Evaluation Criteria

- Quality of the application,
- Quality of the supporting documents,
- Completeness of the application file.

Article 3: Duration

The call for applications will remain open until **February 1st, 2026 (11:59 p.m.)**, which is the submission deadline.

Note: Any application submitted after the deadline will be excluded from the selection process.

Article 4: Combination with Other Awards

These individual prizes are nominative and non-transferable.

Applicants who have already received prizes or scholarships from other University departments during the same period or in previous years must inform us. It is entirely possible to receive multiple prizes or scholarships from the University over the course of your studies.

Article 5: Application File – Required Information and Supporting Documents

Prize categories:

- *Prix de la Fondation “Talents & Inclusion”*
- *Prix de la Fondation “Talents & Solidarité”*

Note: Applicants must select one of the two prizes.

The following information must be included in the form:

- Last name
- First name
- Gender
- Choice of Prize: “Talents & Inclusion” or “Talents & Solidarité”
- Level of study
- Name of the program
- Department / EUR / Portal / School / Program as listed on the enrollment certificate
- Student number
- CV
- Cover letter
- 2025–2026 enrollment certificate
- 2024–2025 transcript (In the case of a gap year in 2024–2025, you may submit your current 2025–2026 semester 1 transcript.)
- Personal or university email address
- Phone number

Note: Any missing information or document in the application file will result in the applicant's elimination from the selection process.

Article 6: Timeline of the Call for Applications

- Until **February 1st, 2026 (11:59 p.m.)**: Call for applications and submission period
- February to late April: Application processing and selection process
- Early May: Results
- **June 5th, 2026**: Prize ceremony for *les Prix de la Fondation*
