

# European Leadership for Safety Education (ELSE)

The ELSE project aims to develop an innovative science-based approach for advanced education in the domain of safety leadership.

## Objectives

1. To develop a certified university diploma in the field of safety leadership based on up-to-date scientific knowledge and best practices;
2. To experiment the training curriculum of this diploma with a group of young professionals from INSC and European countries;
3. To establish the basis for a sustainable development of leadership for safety education:
  - by making leadership for safety education available to students through a network of “implementing European Universities”, as a component of a Master’s degree;
  - by designing a **free** MOOC for a worldwide reach, developed in partnership with SEAM INSA Toulouse: <https://seamonline.insa-toulouse.fr/mod/page/view.php?id=5965&forceview=1>
  - by creating an international and multidisciplinary network of academics and experts in the domain of leadership for safety. The first step towards the creation of this network involved the organization of an international workshop.

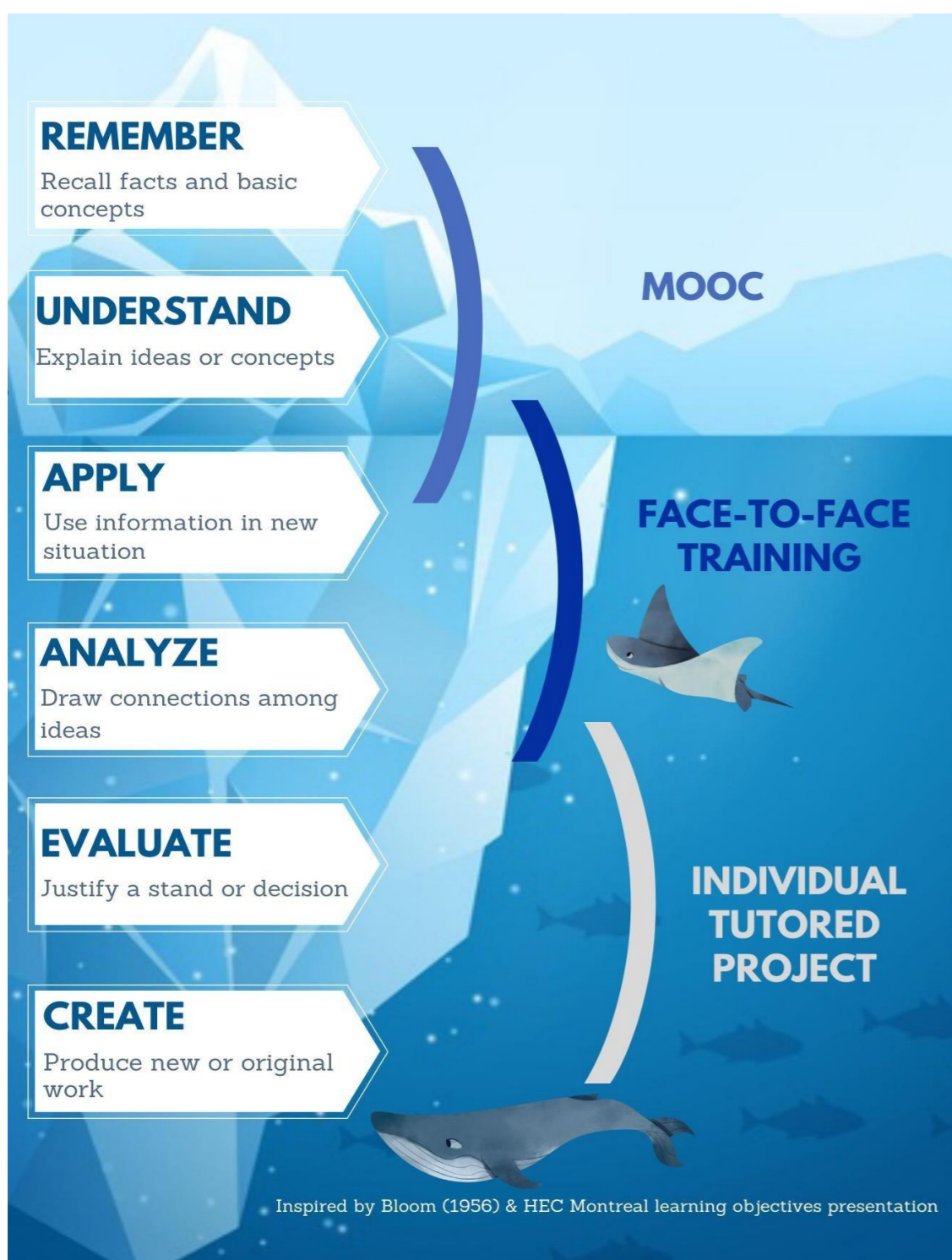
