Cancer Care Equality Scholarships for EMMP Students

Thanks to the generosity of our partner, Johnson & Johnson, we are proud to offer five excellence scholarships for students enrolling in the European MSc in Molecular Pathology (EMMP) for the 2025-2026 academic year. These scholarships will be awarded to outstanding practicing pathologists who demonstrate a strong commitment to advancing molecular pathology, improving patient outcomes, and enhancing the quality of life for cancer patients. Applicants must be employed in a cancer care facility.

Designed to increase accessibility to the program, these scholarships provide financial support to students enrolled in the European MSc in Molecular Pathology, with a particular focus on pathologists from underrepresented regions or resource-limited settings. By removing financial barriers, the scholarships empower talented professionals to pursue advanced training in molecular pathology, equipping them with the expertise needed to address global disparities in precision medicine and drive progress in diagnostics, personalized treatments, and patient care.

Scholarship Award

Each scholarship provides an annual stipend of €5,000 paid in 2 instalments to help EMMP students cover tuition fees and costs associated with on-site courses included in the program.

If the recipient maintains regular attendance and completes the first year with an average grade of at least 14/20, the scholarship will be automatically renewed for the second year with the same stipend.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible, applicants must:

- First submit their application for the European MSc in Molecular Pathology via the Université Côte d'Azur platform, e-candidat.
- Be employed at a cancer care facility

There are no age or nationality restrictions.

Applicants should submit their scholarship application without waiting for the admission results of their MSc program application.



How to apply

- Complete the "Scholarship for Students in Molecular Pathology" application form electronically
- Do not print and fill it out manually.
- Rename the file as "J&J Scholarship Application - [Your Name]".
- Merge the application form with your supporting documents (see list below).
- Send the completed file to msc-emmp@univ-cotedazur.fr before June 1, 2025, 5:00 PM (Paris time).

Required supporting documents

Certain documents submitted with your MSc program application (via the e-candidat platform) will also be used for your scholarship application. These include:

- Your CV
- Academic transcripts
- Two letters of recommendation

You do not need to resubmit these documents; we will access them directly on e-candidats.

However, you must provide the following additional documents:

- The completed scholarship application form
- A motivation letter explaining how you intend to improve cancer patient outcomes and quality of life (please use the space provided in the application form)
- A copy of your employment contract.
